Pro-active Project for PTF NGO Partners

Background

This project was funded by EC UNDP SGP PTF to implement a one-year project called “Pro-active project to support 15 NGO partners of SGP PTF”. The principle thrust of the SGP PTF is to support community-led initiatives that promote sustainable forest use and the management and enhancement of livelihoods.

Purpose of Project

The proactive project aimed to deliver one three round participatory training workshops plus reflection and final workshop to 15 SGP PTF Programme partners (30 participants) in Business Planning; Livelihood and Marketing, Knowledge Management and Project Management/Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation.

Key Results

- On the completion of each Course (3 Rounds of training workshops) the trainee participants should be able to deliver training at an appropriate level to community based organization personnel in the 4 topics of: a. Business Planning; b. Livelihood and Marketing; Knowledge Management and d. Project Management/Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation.
- The skills learned and follow-up in the field should enable the participant organizations to better manage their projects which in turn will;
- iBenefit the community in terms of food security, business activity, income, environment and forest conservation depending on the project supported by the SGP PTF Programme;
- The experience and training will also benefit the SGP PTF partner and associates for any future project or community development projects or activity.
- The courses when developed will be available for others to use

Main Activities

- Assess up to 10 partner organization training needs and capability taking into account their SGP PTF Programme project needs in: a. Business Planning; b. Livelihood and Marketing and c. Knowledge Management, d. Project Management/Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation to design appropriate participatory training for workshops
- Deliver 3 participatory training workshops (One course with 32 trainees i.e. 2 from each of the 16 SGP PTF partner organizations) based on the core topics of a.

Business Planning; b. Livelihood and Marketing; c. Knowledge Management and d. Project Management/Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation.

- Conduct up to 6 Follow-up post training field visits to SGP PTF partner projects focused on the 4 training topics with particular emphasis on Project Management/Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation
- Conduct 2 Final Workshops for all trainee participants to assess lessons learned, possible future training needs and a workshop proceedings report
